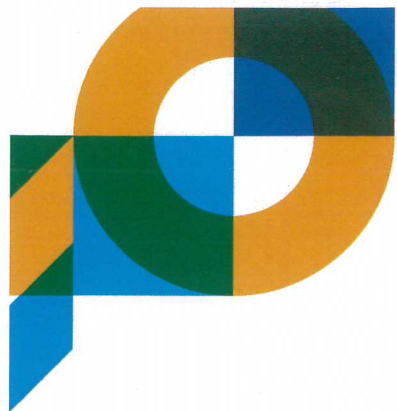

Ph.D. program

up to US \$ 8585 per year
(include tuition and credit fee US \$ 3785, stipend US \$ 4800)
Award period time max to 4 years

Master program

1st year: up to US \$ 7900 per year
(include tuition and credit fee US \$ 5500, stipend US \$ 2400)
2nd year: up to US\$5500



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Besides as above scholarship, the graduate student assistantships will be offered by advisors based on student research performance and funding of research projects.
